POLICY STATEMENT

OBJECTIVES

The Masonic Bursary Program has **two** principal objectives:

- 1. In keeping with the Masonic mission to practice charity, to provide financial assistance to worthy grade twelve graduating students who will pursue a post secondary education leading to a degree or diploma from an approved university in Atlantic Canada; or a diploma, or certificate from an approved Community College in Atlantic Canada.
- 2. To raise the public profile of the Masonic Fraternity; in particular among the young adult population from whom our future membership will come.

ELIGIBILITY

The Program is available to Constituent Lodges or Districts under the jurisdiction of the Grand Lodge of Nova Scotia. The intention is to give bursaries to deserving graduating students attending high schools in each Lodge's local area. Bursary recipients need not have any Masonic affiliation. The Foundation administers the bursary program, but the selection of recipients is completely a function of the individual Lodge through its bursary committee. Lodges are encouraged to consider "financial need" as a criterion in their selection of bursary recipients.

PROGRAM ASSISTANCE

The Program is designed to encourage Lodges or Districts to establish a Bursary Program in their own local community. Encouragement is offered in two ways:

- 1. Assistance to help create the Lodge structure necessary to implement and operate the Program
- 2. A financial contribution to match the Lodge or District funds available for annual Bursaries.

PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION

Lodges or Districts which desire to participate in the Foundation Program will be required to adopt the **minimum criteria** approved by the Foundation and apply in the prescribed manner for inclusion in the Program (**deadline March 31**st). See APPENDIX 'A' <u>Late application will result in refusal of that Lodge's participation for that year</u>.

MINIMUM CRITERIA FOR NOVA SCOTIA FREEMASONS BURSARY PROGRAM

Lodges or Districts which desire to participate in the Foundation Program will be required to adopt the following minimum criteria approved by the Foundation and apply in the prescribed manner for inclusion in the Program (deadline March 31st). See Appendix "D".

- 1. Each Constituent Lodge or District shall appoint a "Bursary Committee" of not less than three persons, one of whom shall be designated as Chairman and Liaison Person to the Foundation.
- 2. The Lodge Bursary Committee shall be responsible for applying in the prescribed manner by **deadline March 31**st, **of each year**, for inclusion in the Program. See APPENDIX 'D'. **Please note the Foundation will share funds only with Lodges or Districts that meet the March 31st deadline.**
- 3. The Lodge Bursary Committee shall be responsible for selecting candidates for bursaries and advising the Program Administrator not later than, **July 15**^{th,} of the year awarded, of Recipient's Name, Social Insurance Number, complete address, phone number and email if available and probable approved University located in Atlantic Canada or Community College in Atlantic Canada at which the Bursary will be tendered. See APPENDIX 'D'
- 4. Bursaries awarded should be designated as: "Nova Scotia Freemasons Bursary Lodge Name and Number". Schools should be notified that their Graduation Ceremony Program should acknowledge this award and be printed as such. It is important that Freemasons of Nova Scotia, receive this publicity. See APPENDIX "E"
- 5. Bursaries shall be awarded to grade twelve **graduating** residents of Nova Scotia who will pursue a post-secondary education program leading to a degree or diploma at an approved University located in Atlantic Canada or a diploma, or certificate at an approved Community College in Atlantic Canada. See APPENDIX "H"
- 6. A Bursary awarded to a student shared one third by the Constituent Lodge and two thirds matched by the Masonic Foundation must be for an amount of no less than \$500 and not greater than 50% of the first years' tuition. Two thirds of the bursary funded by the Foundation is to be limited to a maximum of \$1,500 per bursary.
- 7. Payment of Bursaries awarded will be made by the Foundation directly to the approved degree, diploma, or certificate granting institution selected by the Bursary recipient upon the receipt of an invoice or confirmation of enrollment from the institution. Bursaries must be claimed before **December 31st of the year following the year in which the bursaries were awarded**, unless other satisfactory arrangements are made.
- 8. Constituent Lodges or Districts shall pay to the Foundation their share of the cost of the Bursary not later than May 15th, of the year in which the bursary is awarded. Failure to meet this deadline may result in a Lodge or District paying the full cost of the Bursary awarded.
- 9. Every effort must be made by the Constituent Lodge Bursary Committee to maximize the public relations aspect of the Bursary award, by having the authorized name of the Bursary acknowledged in the school's Graduation Ceremony Program (see No. 4 above) and by presenting the Bursary (through a letter of intent) at the Closing Exercises of the school of the recipient and through suitable news releases in the local media.

Administration - The Masonic Foundation WILL NOT SHARE in bursaries which are restricted to masonic family or their relatives.

- 1. The intent is to give an equal opportunity open to all graduating students irrespective of their sex, religious affiliations etc. who fulfill the Constituent Lodge's Bursary criteria.
- 2. Lodges must apply in the prescribed manner for inclusion in the Program (deadline March 31st).
- 3. Late applications will result in the refusal of the Lodge's participation for that year.
- 4. See Appendices D through H for program administration procedures.
